We believe that instilling a sense of environmental responsibility in our students is pivotal to their holistic growth. As part of this vision, we are launching this Campaign. Each student will be given the opportunity to plant and nurture a sapling under their care. This initiative not only encourages our young learners to connect with nature but also develop a deep sense of stewardship towards our environment.

STEPS & GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS – FOR MONITORING PLANT GROWTH:

- The Plants will be distributed to all the students class wise, between 15.08.2023 and 04.09.2023.
- One type of plant will be provided to one class for e.g. Class-I only Jamun Plant, Class-II only Neem Plant and so on.

Initial Planning:

The plant as given to the student, should be planted in the society, colony or nearby garden. You may invite your friends, relatives, Parshad, Nagar Nigam officials or anyone in your vicinity and approach to be part of your child's own plantation drive. Assist your child in planting their assigned sapling. Ensure it receives adequate sunlight, water and nutrition.

Quarterly Observations:

Encourage your child to regularly observe their plant. They will have to note down observations about the growth of leaves, stems, and any changes in the plant's appearance by maintaining a scrapbook, in which they can document the growth of their planted sapling through a growth chart, geotag photos and report the same to the class teacher every quarter. This activity is designed to encourage their observation skills, record-keeping abilities, and a deeper understanding of the plant's life cycle.

Student is also advised to understand its medicinal purpose and value.

Assessment and Awarding of Marks:

Students will be assessed to take care of the plant. We are delighted to inform that 5 Marks will be awarded for the same and same will be added to their final result.

Note- Your child can write short notes about their plant's progress, any challenges they face, and the care they provide. Incase if the given plants dies, you will have to buy the plant of the same category and plant it again.

Artistic Expression:

Let your child's creativity shine! They can draw, paint, or even compose a short poem inspired by their plant.


