

Audit Report As per CBSE Norms by Thana Moti Doongri







Joga Camp For Healthy Life













MINDFULNESS (Technique of being Present in the Moment)

When a person starts learning any kind of meditation, the first challenge s/he faces is - HOW TO CONTROLTHETRAIL OF THOUGHTS RUNNING UP THERE IN THE MIND?

If you carefully examine your thoughts which come during meditation - they are mostly 'past' or 'future' focused. And when the trainer asks us to focus on our breathing, it still takes lot of practice before we understand its not about 'filling' in the air completely and emptying the lungs out but its about 'feeling' that the air is coming in and going out. So, even if we are in present we sometimes drift away from the task in hand.

Well, mindful meditation comes to rescue us from that quest of controlling the thoughts because it is a technique to rather 'live' the present moment and 'leave' other thoughts aside and the best thing is that it doesn't need any deliberate efforts. With consistent utilisation of our ability to be fully present, aware of where we are and what we're doing, and not getting overly reactive or overwhelmed by what's going on around us, we can master the technique.

Mindful meditation can be done anywhere and whenever you like to do it. Benefits of this meditation include: improved concentration, the ability to focus, academic performance, positive emotions, and ability of acceptance, kindness and compassion. It can help deal with depression and stress. Researchers have found that mindfulness increases the gray matter in our brains.

Mindfulness is an exercise that can change our brain, the way physical workout changes our body:

- It strengthens the connections between the amygdala and the prefrontal cortex. The former is the key player in anxiety and latter, the part of the brain that can calm big emotions. The stronger the connections, the more the pre-frontal cortex is able to take in during anxiety and calm things down.
- Anxiety is driven by a brain that has been cast into the future. Thoughts start out as 'what ifs' and turn into persuasive little beasts that won't let go. It
 teaches the brain to stay in the present.

You can use the following exercises to quickly ground yourself in the present moment:

- Look around and notice 5 things you hadn't noticed before such as a pattern on a wall, light reflecting from a surface etc.
- Try to feel the things around. Feel the pressure of your feet on the floor, your pen in your hand, shirt resting on your shoulders, or the temperature on your skin.
- Notice the background sounds such as friction of chalk on the board, turning of pages by your teacher, birds chirruping, or cars on a distant street.
- Try to smell the things around such as freshly cut grass, the wet soil after rain, flowers or an overflowing trash.
- Pop a piece of chocolate in your mouth, sip a drink, eat a snack, or simply notice how your mouth tastes.

So, unleash the natural curiosity of your mind, pay attention to where you are what's going on around and to start with-Become aware of your body. You can be creative in using your senses and try this exercise while doing an activity like having food, gardening, listening to music, or going for a walk.

The library is well equipped with more than 3500 books very well stacked in open shelves for different subject teaching, environment, literature, dance, music, art, wild life and many





For this, regular lab sessions are held under the guidance of trained lab instructor. In addition to the mandatory laboratories for Physics, Chemistry & Biology, the school also has separate well-equipped Combined Science Lab, Maths Lab, Geography and English Language Lab.

Keeping in pace with the modern times and realising the importance of Computer Education the school feels that IT skills have become a necessity owing to the increasing use of computers in our daily life. To achieve this, we have made computer education compulsory from the very beginning. Students have internet access through 16 MBPS leased line under the strict supervision of Computer Teacher.
