ADVISORY ON SAFETY AND AWARENESS REGARDING STRAY DOGS

Dear Students,

In alignment with the recent guidelines issued by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and directions from the Hon'ble Supreme Court regarding the safety and well-being of children, this circular is being issued to ensure your safety concerning stray dogs within and around the school vicinity and nearby your home.

The school is committed to maintaining a secure environment. To ensure your personal safety, please adhere to the following advisory:

- Awareness and Behavior:** You are encouraged to practice preventive behavior around animals. Avoid approaching, provoking, or feeding stray dogs, as this can lead to unpredictable behavior.
- Reporting Protocol:** If you notice a stray dog within the school premises or observe any aggressive behavior from an animal, please report it immediately to the nearest teacher or school staff member or family member, when at home.
- Safety Measures:** The school has taken active steps to secure the premises with adequate fencing and gates to prevent stray dogs from entering and we expect the same safety measures for your home too.
- Hygiene and Waste:** Proper waste disposal is critical to preventing stray dog habitats. Please ensure all food waste is disposed of only in the designated bins provided, as per PM POSHAN guidelines.

The school has designated a Nodal Officer, Mr. Rajendra Maheshwari (ph- 9887222095) specifically responsible for the upkeep of the premises and ensuring it remains free of stray dog habitats. The contact details for the Nodal Officer are prominently displayed at the school entrance should you or your parents need to report a concern.

Your safety is our primary concern. We will be conducting awareness sessions shortly to further educate everyone on first-aid and safety protocols.
